PROMISSORY NOTE (UNSECURED)

- A draft of the Promissory Note that includes the following:
 - Lender must be listed as "Madison Trust Company, Custodian FBO [Accountholder's name] [MTC Account #]"
 - Amount of loan
 - Date of issuance
 - Interest rate
 - Re-payment terms
 - Maturity date
 - Interest compounding period (annual, quarterly, monthly, daily, none)

• Once the note is finalized, it must be signed and notarized by the borrower prior to funding.

If borrower is a business entity, also submit:

- Articles of Organization or Certificate of Formation
- · Certificate of Good Standing (only applicable if entity has been in existence longer than 12 months)

SECURED PROMISSORY NOTE

In addition to everything required for an unsecured promissory note (see above), please include the applicable security documents.

- If the note is Secured by Real Estate, please include the Deed of Trust
- + If the note is Secured by other Collateral, please include a copy of the applicable security or agreement
